Swingin' the Disney Songbook!

Band Personnel

Matt Johnson, drummer/artistic director/host

Drummer Matt Johnson, lauded as “a hurricane on sticks!” (the Los Angeles Times), is the creator and artistic director of Swingin’ the Disney Songbook! The show reflects the profound impact that Disney Magic has had on him throughout his life - first, as a youngster growing up in Orange, CA, in the shadow of Disneyland, and subsequently as a Disneyland Cast Member himself. He served as a full-time musician at the Disneyland Resort from 1979 to 1990 and continues to appear regularly in shows in and around the Resort. Throughout his freelance music career, Johnson has also performed with a wide range of entertainers, among them singers Julie Andrews and Andy Williams, surf-rock pioneers Jan and Dean, big band legends Billy May and Les Brown, and comedy legends the Smothers Brothers. Since 2014, he has toured annually with A Swingin’ Little Christmas! starring Jane Lynch (Glee, The 40-Year-Old Virgin, The Weakest Link) and Kate Flannery (The Office, Dancing With The Stars). In addition to his busy performance schedule, Johnson is the Professor of Drum Set Studies at Fullerton College, in Fullerton, CA (1993 to present), influencing the next generation of musicians. Miles Jensen, guitar

Latin GRAMMY-winning guitarist Miles Jensen, whose music and artistry reflects his diverse cultural influences, was born and raised in Tokyo, Japan, and has also lived in Los Angeles, San Francisco and New York. His broad musical depth, fiery improvisational skills, and varied performance experiences make him a sought-after guitarist who has recorded and collaborated with a range of artists in the jazz, funk, and R&B arenas, among them Clayton Cameron, Afro-Peruvian Jazz Orchestra, and Nora Germain. An audio engineer as well, his credits include working on numerous music and film scoring sessions in addition to producing and mixing his own work. Jensen is a graduate of the renowned Studio Guitar Studies program at USC's Thornton School of Music and earned a Masters degree on a full scholarship from the school in 2017.

David Miller, bass

Bassist David Miller was raised in a musical household and caught the performance bug at an early age. He has performed, recorded, and toured internationally with such leading artists and ensembles as Ornette Coleman, Betty Carter, the Glenn Miller Orchestra, and the Royal Crown Revue. He holds a Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree in Jazz and Contemporary Music from the New School in NYC and a Fine Arts Masters degree in Jazz Bass Performance from the California Institute of the Arts.

Crystal Lewis, featured vocalist

Born and raised in Southern CA, Crystal Lewis is a 3-time Grammy nominated, multi-Dove award winning singer/songwriter and original cast member of the critically acclaimed Nickelodeon show ROUNDHOUSE. She has graced the world's biggest stages... From The Walt Disney Concert Hall in LA to Carnegie Hall in NY to The Royal Albert Hall in London, and has performed alongside and recorded with Donna Summer, Bono, Mary J. Blige, Arturo Sandoval, Kirk Franklin, Tori Kelly, Kate Flannery, Ally Brooke, Yolanda Adams and CeCe Winans among many others. In addition, both Katy Perry and Tori Kelly consider her an inspiration. Having beautifully transitioned from her more than three decades in gospel music to the wide and wonderful world of Jazz, Crystal brings a whole lot of love and light to the stage. In addition to her long-standing musical career, Crystal now adds AUTHOR to her resume, having written and published her first kids book *Claire Clementine Finds Her Voice*.
